

**VILLAGE OF VINTON  
RESOLUTION NO. 2007-02-06-06**

On the 6<sup>TH</sup> day of February, 2007, the Village Council for the Village of Vinton, Texas, meeting at a regular meeting with an agenda duly posted and, upon a motion and second, passed the following Resolution:

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 395, provides for the authorization of municipalities to assess fees to mitigate cost of infrastructure development; and


**WHEREAS**, the Texas Local code, Chapter 525.015 provides for municipalities to establish and regulate public utilities within its city limits and it extra territorial jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, these fees serve as a substitute for denial of development projects that otherwise would not be served by adequate facilities Texas; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS THAT:**

The City Council of the Village of Vinton, hereby imposes as a condition of development a fee to mitigate impacts on public facilities and services generated by a development project; and, that such fee should be assessed at a rate of \$7.00 per linear foot for the purpose of a water service connection for commercial properties located within the city limits and within its Extra Territorial Jurisdiction when service is to be provided through an existing municipally owned line.
