

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-10-7-1

A RESOLUTION BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS ADOPTING A TAX EXEMPTION FOR PERSONS OVER AGE 65 OR WHO ARE DISABLED OF A PORTION OF THE APPRAISED VALUE OF THEIR RESIDENCE HOMESTEAD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,000.00.

WHEREAS, V.T.C.A., Tax Code §11.13(d) permits the Village of Vinton to grant disabled persons or persons age 65 or older an exemption from taxation of a portion of the appraised value of their residence homestead.

WHEREAS, the Village Council deems it in the best interest of citizens of the Village of Vinton to grant its disabled or elderly homeowners such an exemption from taxation in the amount of \$3,000.00 of the appraised value of their residence homestead.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS, that:

1. The Vinton Village Council hereby adopts an exemption from taxation for disabled persons or persons age 65 or older in the amount of \$3,000.00 of the appraised value of such persons' residence homestead.


