

RESOLUTION 2009-1-20-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING EL PASO WATER UTILITES - PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD (EPWU-PSB), TO SUBMIT, ON BEHALF OF VINTON, AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION (EDA) GRANT APPLICATION TO THE AUSTIN, TEXAS, OFFICE OF EDA; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE VINTON'S PARTICIPATION IN SUCH AN EDA-FUNDED PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Village of Vinton desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing, suitable living environment, potable water service, and economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and

WHEREAS, conditions exist representing a threat to public health and safety; and


WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of Vinton to receive grant funding from the Economic Development Administration (EDA) of the United States of America;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS:

1. That an application to EDA for grant funding is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of Vinton by El Paso Water Utilities-Public Service Board (EPWU-PSB).
2. That this application be placed in competition for funding under the EDA Program.
3. That the application be for approximately \$975,000.00 of grant funds to carry out water system improvements.
4. That the City Council directs and designates the Mayor as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the EDA Grant Program.
5. That it further be stated that the Village of Vinton is committing approximately \$126,000.00 from its General Fund as a cash contribution toward the administrative, engineering and construction activities of this water system improvements program.
