BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON:

SECTION 1: That an application is hereby approved and authorized to be filed with the Texas Water Development Board seeking financial assistance in an amount not to exceed \$1,295,000.00, to provide for the costs of a municipal wide waste water system.

SECTION 2: That Mayor Madeleine Praino be and is hereby designated the authorized representative of the Village of Vinton for purposes of furnishing such information and executing such documents as may be required in connection with the preparation and filing of such application for financial assistance and the rules of the Texas Water Development Board.




