

**RESOLUTION NO. 2010- 3-9-2**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS  
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND  
COMMUNITY AFFAIRS HOUSING TRUST FUND (HTF) APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS  
DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AN COMMUNITY AFFAIRS; AND AUTHORIZING THE  
MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED  
REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN  
THE HTF PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the Village of Vinton, Texas desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunity principally for persons of low to moderate income and persons with disabilities, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Vinton, Texas is a unit of Local Government making it an eligible applicant for the HTF Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the HTF Program is to provide assistance to eligible households through the Home Free Barrier Removal and Rehabilitation Assistance Program to persons with disabilities whose household incomes do not exceed 80% of the Area Median Family Income (AMFI). Assistance will be in the form of one-time grants of up to \$20,000 per household to make homes (rental or owner-occupied) more accessible.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS;**

1. That a Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs application for the HTF Program is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the Village of Vinton, Texas
2. That the application be for the amount of \$100,000 dollars to carry out the scope of proposed program eligible activities.
3. That in addition to project funds awarded, applicants may receive an amount equal to 10% of their award for administration.
4. That the City has cash reserves in the amount of \$30,000 for expenditures related to the implementation of the program.
5. That the City Council direct and designates Mayor Madeleine Praino as an authorized representative to execute the contract and act in all matters in connection with this application and the city's participation in said program.
6. That if further be stated that the assisted homeowner must be low to moderate Income.
