

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-5-4-3

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS TO CERTIFY FUNDING AND SUPPORT FOR THE STATEWIDE TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM NOMINATION FORM 2009 WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE APPLICATION TO RECEIVE FUNDING TO BUILD A BIKE/PEDESTRIAN TRAIL; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Village of Vinton, Texas desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunity principally for persons of low to moderate income; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Vinton, Texas is a unit of Local Government making it an eligible applicant for the Texas Department of Transportation Enhancement Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Vinton, Texas wishes to improve the safety and efficiency of the movement of people through biking or walking; and

WHEREAS, the Arroyo Trail is a viable and important asset to the city, schools and local businesses; and

WHEREAS, the building of the Arroyo Trails will accomplish this intention;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS;

The Village of Vinton, Texas has submitted an application for funding through the Texas Department of Transportation to make necessary improvements to accomplish a bike/pedestrian trail. The City agrees to commit to the project's development, implementation, construction, maintenance, management and financing. The City further agrees to provide the required local match of 20% or greater of the total project cost, including the responsibility for all non-federally fundable items and 100 percent of all overruns.
