

**RESOLUTION NO. 2012-6-5-1**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS  
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A SECTION 533 HOUSING PRESERVATION GRANT  
APPLICATION 2012 TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE ; AND  
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND  
AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S  
PARTICIPATION IN THE 533 HOUSING PRESERVATION GRANT PROGRAM.**

- WHEREAS,** the City Council of the Village of Vinton, Texas desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunity principally for persons of low to moderate income; and
- WHEREAS,** the Village of Vinton, Texas is a unit of Home Rule Local Government making it an eligible applicant for the 533 Housing Preservation Grant Program; and
- WHEREAS,** the 533 Housing Preservation Grant Program is to provide eligible low or very-low households with grant or loans for the repair or rehabilitation of existing owner occupied housing or rental properties.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS;**

1. That a 533 Housing Preservation Grant Program is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the Village of Vinton, Texas;
2. That the application be for the amount of \$100,000 dollars to carry out the scope of proposed program eligible activities;
3. That in addition to project funds awarded, applicants may receive an amount equal to 15% of their award for administration;
4. That the City Council direct and designates the Mayor as the City's Chief Executive Officer an authorized representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the city's participation in said program;
5. That it further be stated that the assisted homeowner must be low to very low income;
6. That the City commits the amount of \$3,000 in in-kind services as match for this proposal.
