

Resolution 2013-11-19-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE- RURAL DEVELOPMENT (USDA-RD) GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A MUNICIPAL WASTEWATER SYSTEM; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE- RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the City of to avail itself of the United States Department of Agriculture- Rural Development Program;

WHEREAS, the Village of Vinton meets the definition of a Colonia for the purpose of project funding under the Rural Utilities Service (RUS) Section 306, Colonia Water and Wastewater Disposal Grant Program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON , TEXAS;

1. That a USDA-RD Program application is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the City.
2. That the application be for the design and construction of a **Municipal Wastewater System for the Village of Vinton not to exceed \$22 million.**
3. That the Village Council directs and designates Mayor Madeleine Praino as the Village's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application.
4. That the Mayor and Council have the responsibility, authority and means to pursue the development of a public wastewater system, control future development, and coordinate multi-agency participation.
