

RESOLUTION No. 2013-4-2-3

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON CITY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS RESERVATION SYSTEM; AND AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE HOME PROGRAM RESERVATION SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE OF VINTON desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the VILLAGE OF VINTON to participate in the HOME Program Reservation System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS;

1. That the agreement to participate in the Home Investment Partnerships Program Reservation System be submitted to the Texas Department of Housing and Community affairs on behalf of the Village of Vinton Texas.
2. City has unencumbered fund for cash reserves to be utilized, if necessary, during the RSP agreement term;
3. That the City directs and designates the Mayor Madeleine Praino, as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this agreement and the City's participation in the HOME Program, including execution of the City's HOME Reservation System Participant Agreement.
