A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS AMY YOUNG BARRIER REMOVAL RESERVATION SYSTEM PROGRAM (Amy Young Program) ; AND AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN PROGRAM.

- WHEREAS, The Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs provides assistance to assistance for low-income and disabled families under the AMY YOUNG PROGRAM.
- WHEREAS, the VILLAGE OF VINTON desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and
- WHEREAS, certain housing conditions exist which represent accessibility barriers and a threat to the public health and safety; and
- WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village of Vinton to participate in the Amy Young Program to secure available resources to improve the housing conditions and accessibility measures of its residents:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS:

1. That an application to participate in the Amy Young Program be submitted to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs on behalf of the Village of Vinton, Texas.
2. That the City directs and designates Mayor Madeleine Praino, as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this program.
