

RESOLUTION No. 2017-2-21-2
Village of Vinton, Texas

WHEREAS, El Paso Electric Company, distributes electric power within the city limits of the Village of Vinton pursuant to a franchise granted to El Paso Electric Company by the City, and is an electric utility; and

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2017, El Paso Electric Company (“EPE” or the “Company”), filed with the Village of Vinton its Application of El Paso Electric Company to Change Rates and to Reconcile Fuel Costs, Docket No. 46831, before the Public Utility Commission of Texas; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to applicable law, the Village of Vinton maintains original jurisdiction over rates of El Paso Electric Company for rates charged within the city limits of the Village of Vinton and the Application specifies that the rate change within the City’s jurisdiction should be effective on March 20, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that additional time and information is needed for it to study the proposed rate changes and tariffs and the reasons therefore;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Public Utility Regulatory Act, Texas Utilities Code Section 36.108, the Village of Vinton, as regulatory Authority, has the right to suspend the proposed rate change subject to the City’s jurisdiction for a period of 90 days after the proposed date the change would otherwise be effective; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of its citizens and ratepayers to suspend the proposed rate change.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON:

1. That the rate increase identified in the Application of El Paso Electric Company to Change Rates and to Reconcile Fuel Costs be and is hereby suspended for 90 days after the effective date for the rate increase subject to the City’s jurisdiction as specified in the filing.
2. That the Mayor or his designee shall so notify El Paso Electric Company of the suspension and the order to submit working papers by having a copy of this Resolution delivered or mailed to the Senior Regulatory Case Manager, or other authorized recipient of official documents, of the Company.
