

ORDINANCE NO. 094-126

AN ORDINANCE ORDERING AN ELECTION OF THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS, ON THE 21ST DAY OF JANUARY, 1995, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING OR REJECTING A PROPOSED ONE (1%) PERCENT SALES AND USE TAX FOR THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS, THAT:

I.

In accordance with the laws and Constitution of the State of Texas, an election shall be and is hereby called and ordered for the 21st day of January, 1995, at which election all qualified voters may vote for the purpose of adopting or rejecting a one (1%) percent sales and use tax for the Village of Vinton, Texas.

II.

The Vinton Village Clerk shall prepare ballots to be used in said election and shall stamp same "Official Ballot" on which ballot shall be printed:

"A one (1%) percent sales and use tax is adopted within the City."

The Village Clerk shall also prepare the ballots in the Spanish language.

III.

The polls shall be kept open from 7:00 o'clock a.m. until 7:00 o'clock p.m., and that due return be made to the Village Council showing the number of votes cast **FOR** and the number of votes cast **AGAINST** the proposed one (1%) percent sales tax for the Village of Vinton, Texas.

IV.

That this Ordinance, signed by the Mayor and attested by the Village Clerk, shall constitute the calling and ordering of said election, and that such notice shall be published

in a newspaper of general circulation in the Village of Vinton, Texas, once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks prior to the election, and the Village Clerk is hereby directed to post, or cause to be posted, said notice at least twenty (20) days before said election in each voting precinct.

All notices shall be prepared in both the English and Spanish languages.

V.

The polling place for this election shall be at the Vinton Village Hall and shall be properly conducted by the El Paso County Election Department and the Department's personnel.


VI.

That this Ordinance was duly enacted with all requisites and formalities incident thereto the enactment of ordinances, and such is evidenced by the below signatures.
