## ORDINANCE NO. <u>094-143</u>

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING BUSINESSES WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS, TO ACQUIRE AND MAINTAIN DUMPSTERS FOR BUSINESS TRASH ACCUMULATED THROUGH ITS OPERATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS, THAT:

I.

Pursuant to Section 122.005 of the Texas Health and Safety Code, this Ordinance is created and shall require the following:

II.

All businesses operating within the municipal limits of the Village of Vinton, Texas, shall acquire and maintain dumpsters, either separately or in cooperation with other businesses, for the purpose of the collection and removal of any trash which is created by the operation of their business.

III.

Businesses are further required to have the dumpsters emptied at least one time per week and shall not permit the dumpsters to be left in a condition that is dangerous to public health and safety.

IV.

Violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor, and a fine shall be imposed in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.00.

That this Ordinance was duly enacted with all requisites and formalities incident thereto the enactment of ordinances, and such is evidenced by the below signatures.
