ORDINANCE NO. 096-416

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING UNOPPOSED
CANDIDATES ELECTED TO OFFICE IN THE
VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS

Whereas, §2.051 - §2.054 of the Texas Election Code authorizes the election to office of unopposed candidates by ordinance rather than by formal election; and

Whereas, the Village Clerk has certified that the candidates seeking public office at the election of May 4, 1996, whose names will appear on the official ballot, are unopposed; and

Whereas, no propositions are to appear on the ballot for the election of May 4, 1996; and

Whereas, an election to be held where all candidates are unopposed would require the unnecessary expenditure of fees and expenses for the cost of the election;

Now therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS, THAT:

I.

Samuel Monreal is hereby declared elected to the office of Mayor of the Village of Vinton, Texas.

Abraham J. Hernandez is hereby declared elected to the office of Alderman Place 1 of the Village of Vinton, Texas.

Orlando L. Munoz is hereby declared elected to the office of Alderman Place 2 of the Village of Vinton, Texas.

II.

The term of each office listed above shall commence at such time that it would commence if an election were held on May 4, 1996.

III.

A copy of this Ordinance shall be posted on May 4, 1996, at each polling place that would have been used in this election.


IV.

After May 4, 1996, a certificate of election shall be issued to each candidate in the same manner as provided for each candidate elected at the election.


V.
