

ORDINANCE NO. 121702

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE
FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2003,
AND ENDING ON DECEMBER 31, 2003, FOR THE
VILLAGE OF VINTON, TEXAS**

WHEREAS, the proposed Village Budget prepared and submitted by the Mayor of the Village of Vinton, on the 17th day of December 2002, was filed with the Village Secretary for the Village of Vinton, Texas, and said proposed budget remained on the file for public inspection with the Village Secretary; and

WHEREAS, proper notice was given the residents by posting of the proposed Village Budget and consideration of adopting said budget by Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, at said hearing, all desiring to contest the said proposed Village Budget for the fiscal year of January 1, 2003, to December 31, 2003, correct the same, or in any manner be heard concerning the benefits thereof, or in any other matters requiring rectification which were called to the attention of Council were rectified and corrected;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF VINTON, THAT:

SECTION I.

That the action of the Village Council closing the hearing and overruling the protests are hereby ratified and confirmed by this Ordinance. That the Village Council, from the evidence finds that the adoption of the proposed Village Budget, which was prepared by the Mayor or the Village of Vinton, and then left on the file with the Village Secretary for public inspection, is in the best interests of the Citizens of Vinton, Texas, and will further the purpose and goals of the Citizens of the Village, and will enable the government of the Village of Vinton, Texas, to carry out it's necessary function.

SECTION II.

The Village Budget, which is attached to this Ordinance, is adopted in full, and contained therein said budget, the Village of Vinton, Texas will operate during the fiscal year of January 1, 2003, to December 31, 2003, on a budget of \$788,717.

SECTION III.

The Village Budget shall be on file with the Village Secretary for public inspection throughout the fiscal year of January 1, 2003, to December 31, 2003, and a true and

correct copy of same will be delivered, in hand, at the Village Secretary's Office upon the request of any citizen of the Village of Vinton, Texas.

SECTION IV.

That this Ordinance was duly enacted with all requisites and formalities incident thereto the enactment of ordinances, and such is evidenced by the below signatures.
